Artist's work on show

A CANADIAN artist who has moved to England with her family is exhibiting her recent work in Hertford until St Valentine's Day. Shelley Campbell, who came to live in the Cotswolds with her

English poet husband Richard Vick and their three young children two years ago, is displaying drawings and paintings at the Courtyard Arts Centre, Port Vale.

The show, which opened on Tuesday, includes paintings of her family and friends, but not in a conventional portrait form.

Her paintings rely more on gesture, shape and light than the depiction of features.
